

## COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS

**BOOK CLUB NEWS:** The next meeting of the CTK Book Club is May 4th, 7pm in the CTK Social Hall. **DO UNTO OTHERS...** Please be considerate of our neighbors when parking for CTK services. When parking on the street, let's be aware of any parking restrictions and also give our neighbors enough room to get in and out of their driveways. Thank you!

**MORE SOWERS! —MAKE SURE YOUR REPRESENTATIVE OPPOSES THE SHULER-TANCREDO BILL** — This bill – the Save Act – does not solve the immigration problem in a Christian manner. Many representatives in Congress have already opposed it – John Kline, Michele Bachmann, and Jim Ramstad. Write to your representatives (you can find names and addresses of legislators by accessing their website at the Legislative Contacts tab on the Sowers website ([www.ctksowers.org](http://www.ctksowers.org)) and urge them to sign the "discharge petition" for the bill. The U.S. Catholic Bishops believe that, if enacted, this bill will drive undocumented immigrants and their families further underground, thus creating a hidden society of persons without full rights in their communities.

**SERVE AS AN ELECTION JUDGE—THE ELECTIONS OF 2008** are quickly approaching and the Office of Elections & Voter Registration are in need of qualified applicants. The primary on Sept. 9 and the General Election on November 4 are expected to have heavy voter turnout and additional election judges are needed for these elections.
