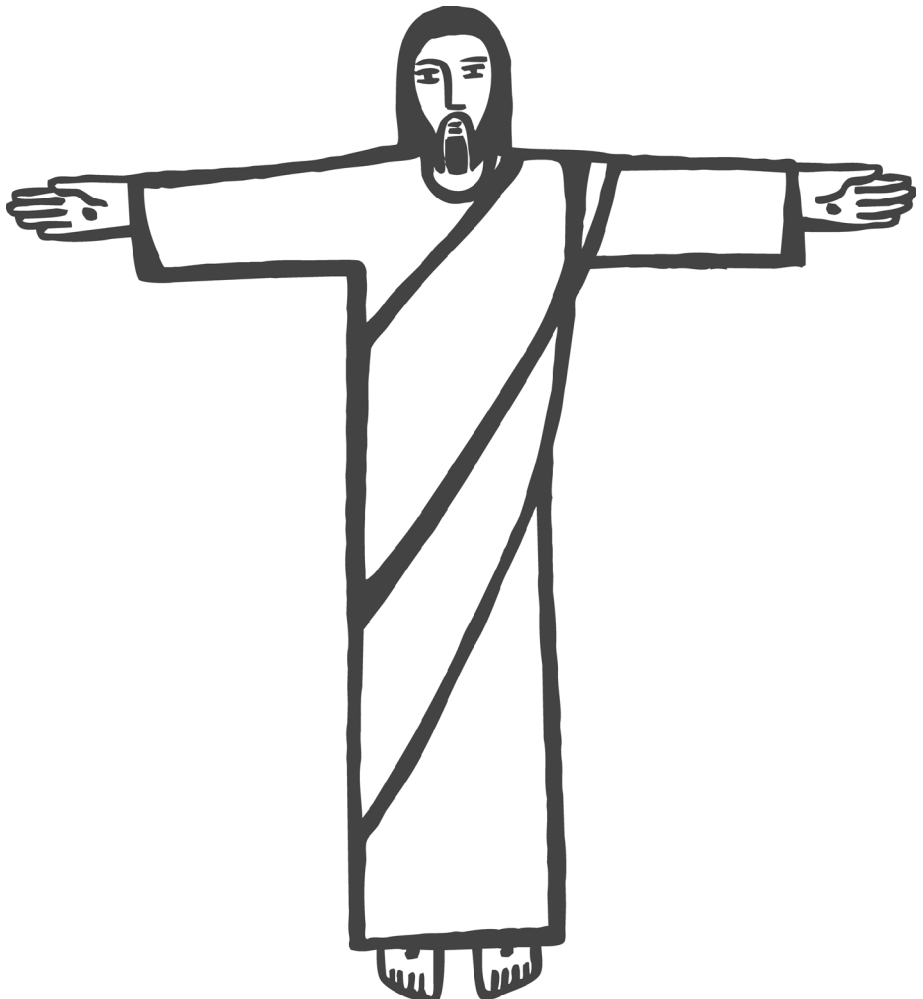

**MAKE SURE YOUR REPRESENTATIVE OPPOSES THE SHULER-TANCREDO BILL** -- This bill, the Save Act, does not solve the immigration problem in a Christian manner. Many representatives in Congress have already opposed it, John Kline, Michele Bachmann, and Jim Ramstad. Write to your representatives (go to the [www.ctksowers.org](http://www.ctksowers.org) and click on the Legislative Contacts tab to find the names & addresses of your legislator.) and urge them to sign the “discharge petition” for the bill. The U.S. Catholic Bishops believe that, if enacted, this bill will drive undocumented immigrants and their families further underground, creating a hidden society of persons without full rights in their communities.
